

# HOOP IT UP CLASSIC

## Basketball Rules 2009

Each team is guaranteed 4 games.

A scorekeeper and timekeeper will be provided for each game. The home team will be determined by the scorekeeper.

Players can only play for one team. Additions/deletions to a roster must be complete before the first game.

Teams must have numbered/same colored jerseys. It is recommended to show up with 2 sets of tops. (light/dark)

Team coaches will put their lineup in the official book prior to the scheduled game.

Teams will provide their own balls for warm-ups.

A team may be suspended from further play for unsportsmanlike behavior. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated from players, coaches, or fans.

### PLAYING RULES

1. Games will consist of two 20 minute halves. The clock will stop the last two minutes of the game on all whistles unless one team is ahead by more than 15 points.
2. Overtime periods are two minutes in length, with a stopped clock on all whistles. Teams will get one time out per overtime. 2<sup>nd</sup> overtime will be sudden death. The first team to score wins.
3. Three 60 second timeouts per game will be allowed. Unused time outs will not carry over into overtime.
4. Halftime will consist of three minutes.
5. The three point shot will be allowed in all divisions.
6. Full-court press will be allowed in all divisions. A team cannot press if they are up by 10 points or more.
7. Zone defenses are allowed in all divisions except 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Violations will result in a first time warning; thereafter 2 free throws will be awarded with the shooting team staying in possession of the ball.
8. Players must compete in their own grade classifications. Exception: Players may play in an older division. Players may play on **one team only**.
9. Game time is forfeit time. A team can start a game with a minimum of 4 players.
10. All age divisions will use a women's size ball, with the exception of 7<sup>th</sup> thru 9<sup>th</sup> grade boys. They will use a regulation men's ball.

Each facility will have a Gym Supervisor available.
